What's involved?

Rotaract Clubs can be sponsored by a Rotary Club or another Rotaract Club. Rotaract members decide how to organize and run their clubs, manage their own funds, and plan and carry out activities and service projects. Sponsor Rotary Club offer guidance and support and work with your club as partners in service.



* Before 2019, there was an upper age limit of 30 but the Rotary International removed the upper limit at the Council of Legislature 2019. Rotaractor were made equal partner to Rotarian.

Goal of Rotaract

Rotaract has six goals:

- Develop professional and leadership skills
- Emphasise respect for the rights of others, based on recognition of the worth of each individual
- Recognise the dignity and value of all useful occupations as opportunities to serve
- Recognise, practice and promote ethical standards as leadership qualities and vocational responsibilities
- Develop knowledge and understanding of the needs, problems and opportunities in the community and worldwide
- Provide opportunities for personal and group activities to serve the community and promote international understanding and goodwill to all people



Why join Rotaract?

Rotaract connects you to a network of business, professional, and community leaders to facilitate the development of your personal and professional skills. Clubs seek industry experts to share stories and guidance, invite motivational speakers to meetings, and



regularly engage in workshops and training on personal growth areas including leadership and communication.

District 3310 has 72 Rotary Clubs and 35 Rotaract Clubs. Through community and international service projects, Rotaractors help improve the lives of the people around them.

The primary focus is community service, from a couple of hours volunteering in your local area, to weeks building townships in third world countries.

The concept of the Rotaract eClub is simple – membership is open to young professionals who are interested in service within the district. You will meet once-a-month virtually, so you can join from wherever you are at your convenience. An additional advantage of joining an e-club is that you automatically expose yourself to professionals from around the district, creating an online network of friends.

You're encouraged to participate in Rotary activities as a member of the club, but as a service-oriented individual, you can still take part in service projects in your community through an organization of your liking. You can also connect to other Rotaract Clubs in your area to do joint projects, expanding on the idea of collaboration for service.

To start the community base E-Rotaract Club, RC Luyang as the primary sponsor and co-sponsor by RC Jurong Town will help to manage the club for at least five years. Subscription to Rotary International will be USD8.00 per member and you won't be paying until 2022.
